

Event Title: Fostering Transdisciplinary Collaborations at the Nexus of Climate and Health for Global Environmental Change Research—a Way Forward
Bangkok, Thailand
October 23-27, 2024

The five-day event promotes transdisciplinary, multi-lateral, and multi-sectoral climate and health research and practices to improve human health. The event sponsors are NSF, the U.S. Department of State, the Japan Science and Technology Agency (JSTA), and the Thailand Science Research and Innovation (TSRI), which support nine funding agencies in Thailand. The symposium aims to bridge funding agencies and early-career researchers in the ASEAN countries and share funding information and research projects. Each MOHIP team member will give an individual presentation on the grant application, writing, and transdisciplinary team collaborations. In addition, three other faculty and grant administrators will contribute virtually to the event by sharing grant applications, writing, and administration experiences. In addition, the symposium organizers will host a special event for Michigan State University, “MSU Night,” during the program. Over 20 guests are invited to this event.

Drs. Ghimire and Xia had met MOHIP program partners from Laos, Thailand, Vietnam and more researchers from other ASEAN countries. They also talked with the funding agency representatives and introduced MOHIP work and research at Michigan State University. They look forward to expanding the MOHIP network and increasing funding for future programs.
